

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
OF THE
SOUTH CAROLINA NUMISMATIC ASSOCIATION

October 29, 1994 Hyatt Regency Hotel Greenville, SC

The General Membership meeting was called to order by President Samuel E. Norris at 9:44 am. The invocation was given by Mr. Norman Boggs.

Convention Chairman, Mr. Austin M. Sheheen, Jr. reported that a quorum of 26 SCNA members were present and that we had the needed quota to conduct business.

Mr. James Vernon Epps announced that the 3rd Annual SCNA Morning Worship Service would be held Sunday at 8 am in the Crepe Myrtle Room and the Awards Breakfast would follow at 9 am.
