

# BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA NUMISMATIC ASSOCIATION

October 28, 2001 Palmetto Exposition Center Greenville, SC

Newly elected SCNA President Anthony F. Chibbaro called the SCNA Board of Governors to order at 10am. Mr. Edwin Wood gave the invocation.

Secretary Pascal Brock orally reviewed the minutes of the October 26 Board and the October 27 General Membership meetings with the new Board. On a motion by Mr. LoRan Ross that was seconded by Mr. Wendell Brush the oral review of minutes were approved.
