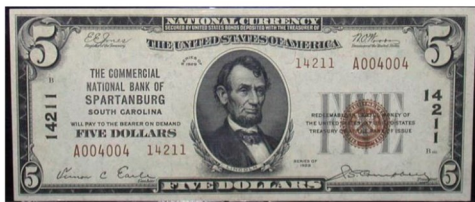
“A Beginner’s Guide to Collecting National Bank Notes”

YN Program at the convention

This year's YN program at the SCNA Annual Convention will be similar to last year's program with one new game, all new quizzes, new prizes, and a new layout and location on the bourse floor. 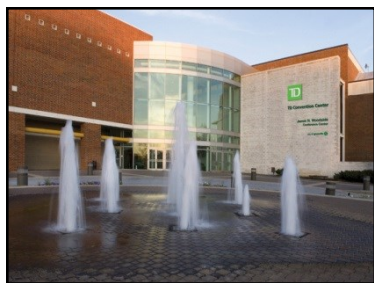

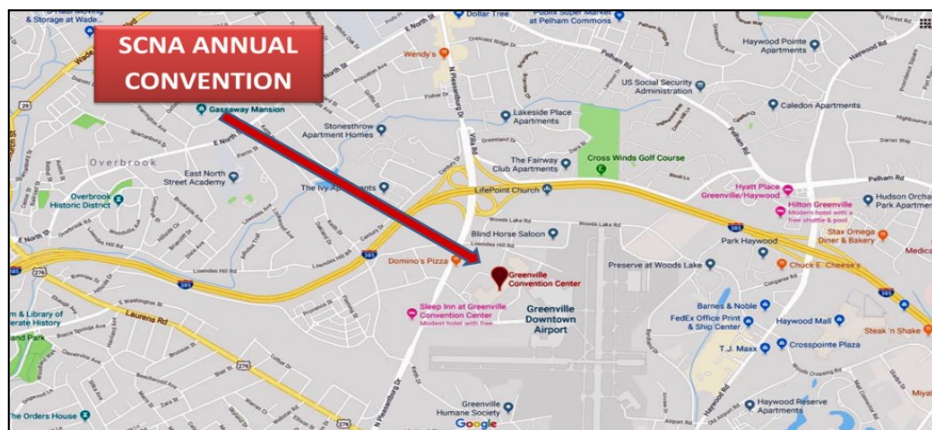
