Course Synopsis:

SCNA-S100: Introduction to Grading of US Coins (8hrs).

Description: Three hours of classroom instruction regarding entry level general grading of problem-free U.S. Coins, followed by five hours of hands-on regrading of certified U.S. Coins (PCGS, NGC, ANACS). Bring your ANA Colorized Grading Standard and 10x power loop. Both will be available from Supply Dealer at Convention.

Credits Earned:

SCNA-S101: Intermediate Grading of U.S. Coins (8hrs).

Pre-requisite: SCNA-S100

Description: Two hours of classroom instruction regarding intermediate detailed grading, determination of cleaning, doctoring & whizzing of U.S. coins, followed by 6 hours of hands-on regrading of certified (PCGS, NGC, ANACS) and raw U.S. Coins. Must score $\geq 80\%$ on final exam to pass.

Credits Earned:

SCNA-S102: Advanced Grading of U.S. Coins (16 hrs).

Pre-requisite: SCNA-100, SCNA-S101, SCNA S200

Description: Three hours of classroom instruction regarding counterfeit equipment, methods and identification of counterfeit and altered U.S. Coins, followed by 5 hours of hands on regarding and authentication of certified and raw U.S. Coins.

Credits Earned:

SCNA-S200: Introduction to counterfeit detection of U.S. Coins. (8hrs)

Description: Three hours of classroom instruction regarding identification of counterfeit and altered U.S. Coins, counterfeit detection methods and equipment followed by 5 hours of Hands-on re-grading and authentication of certified and raw U.S. Coins.

Credits Earned:

SCNA-S201: Advanced Counterfeit Detection of U.S. Coins (8 hrs)

Prerequisites: SCNA-S-200

Description: Three hours of classroom instruction regarding counterfeit detection equipment, methods and identification of counterfeit and altered U.S. Coins, followed by 5 hours of hands-on re-grading and authentication of certified and raw U.S. Coins. Emphasis will be on pre-1930's gold and key and semi-key date coins of all series. Must score >90% on the final exam to pass.

SCNA-S400: Introduction to Grading of US Currency (8hrs).

Description: Three hours of classroom instruction regarding entry level general grading of problem-free U.S. Currency, followed by five hours of hands-on regrading of certified U.S. Currency (PMG etc.). Bring your Friedburg Book and light. Both will be available from Supply Dealer at Convention.
